INVITES PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE PROPOSED PLAN
FOR THE E.C. ELECTROPLATING (GARFIELD) SUPERFUND SITE

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announces the opening of a 30-day comment period on the preferred plan to address the groundwater contamination at the E.C. Electroplating Superfund site in Garfield, New Jersey. The preferred remedy and other alternatives are identified in the Proposed Plan.

The comment period begins on Monday, May 9, 2016 and ends on June 8, 2016. As part of the public comment period, EPA will hold a public meeting on May 19, 2016 at 7PM at the Garfield Senior Center, 480 Midland Ave., Garfield NJ.
