## 2016 - 2017 CURBSIDE RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL RECYCLING PROGRAM RULES AND REGULATIONS

### **CO-MINGLED ITEMS**

Due to changes in the NJ DEP. mandate, all co-mingled bottles and cans must be placed in either your **BLUE BARREL, OR CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS** if you have one or in your own barrel with a "RECYCABLES ONLY LABEL" that is given out at the DPW. We will only accept a clear plastic bag with co-mingled items, all other bags will be left at the curb, and you could be given a summons, for failing to adhere to the new rules. **DO NOT PUT** Dishes, Light Bulbs, Mirrors, Aerosol Cans, or other garbage in your Blue Recycling Barrel. These items are regular garbage. If you are unsure of what items are to be recycled, please call first.

### **PAPER ITEMS**

**RECYCLE NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINES, JUNK MAIL & CARDBOARD. NEWSPAPER MUST BE TIED IN BUNDLES** separate from your cardboard. Cardboard **MUST BE FLATTENED AND TIED IN BUNDLES. ALL BUNDLES MUST NOT EXCEEDING 40lbs. DO NOT** set out loose paper or cardboard.

### **APPLIANCES**

Appliances will be picked up one day per week **BY APPOINTMENT ONLY**. Please call 973-546-2200 to set up your appliance pick up. Set out your appliance **AFTER 6:00pm** the day before your pickup.

### **ELECTRONICS**

**CAN NO LONGER BE PUT OUT WITH YOUR REGULAR GARBAGE DUE TO A NEW STATE DEP. MANDATE** We will be accepting **Electronic Scrap (computers, monitors, wires/cables, keyboards, mouse, telephones, computer components, VCRs, DVD players, stereos and microwave ovens)** at the DPW Monday - Friday, 7:00am to 2:00pm. No Saturdays or Sundays. **You MUST REPORT TO THE FRONT OFFICE BEFORE DISPOSING** of your electronics. **NO CURBSIDE PICKUP. TELEVISIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED, must be delivered to DPW, any problems call 973-546-2200.**

**ALL RECYCABLES MUST BE PLACED AT THE CURB AFTER 6:00PM THE DAY BEFORE** your designated collection day as stated on your calendar.

**YOUR BLUE RECYCLING BARREL IS NOT TO BE USED** for your regular garbage. This barrel is for **RECYCABLES ONLY**. In case of **INCLEMENT WEATHER, DO NOT** set out your recyclables. Please call the office and you will be informed of what to do.

**ALL MUST RECYCLE. VIOLATORS OF GARFIELD'S RECYCLING ORDINANCE WILL RECEIVE A WARNING, AND THEN FINED FOR EACH VIOLATION THEREAFTER.**



For many years, City residents have recycled tons of recyclables saving the City hundreds of thousands of dollars in garbage disposal fees. The City now is receiving monthly rebates for our newspaper/cardboard and commingled items. For the year 2015 we have realized a great savings for our City. We have in place a white goods/appliance/metal recycling program, which has been very successful due to your continuous compliance. Put out your appliance/metal after 6:00pm the day before pickup. If need be, you can bring your appliance metal to the DPW, Mon-Fri 7:00am to 3:00pm if you have an emergency.
