The Bergen County Utilities Authority (BCUA) is pleased to announce the Household Hazardous Waste Management and Disposal Program schedule for 2015. The BCUA will conduct eight (8) household hazardous waste collection events in 2015. These one-day events will be held at different locations throughout Bergen County on weekend dates throughout the calendar year. The events are scheduled for the following dates and locations:

- **Please note: These events do *not* accept document shredding, electronics or automobile tires.**


All event hours are 9 AM – 3 PM rain or shine. The household hazardous waste management program offers Bergen County residents the opportunity to properly dispose of household hazardous waste items such as aerosol cans, paints, pesticides, solvents and many other hazardous items commonly found in a home. These events are available free of charge to all Bergen County Residents.

Small businesses can also deliver up to 220 pounds of hazardous waste to the collection events for a predetermined disposal fee. Preregistration is required for small businesses. Residents and interested parties can contact the household hazardous waste management hotline at (201) 807-5825 or visit us online at www.bcu.org any time of day for a scheduling of events, a listing of household waste products we are collecting or to receive a hazardous waste registration and service inventory form.

The BCUA is soliciting assistance to help inform residents about the importance in the proper disposal of household hazardous waste materials. This program gives Bergen County residents an environmentally safe disposal option for these unwanted items. The BCUA will be distributing flyers to your municipality in early February. We ask that you display these flyers throughout your municipality. It is our hope that, together, we can help reduce the illegal disposal of hazardous waste material.
