RESOLUTION – AUTHORIZING APPOINTMENT OF APPRAISAL SYSTEMS TO PROVIDE COUNTY APPEAL DEFENSE SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF GARFIELD FOR THE 2013 TAX APPEALS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council believe that it would be in the best interests of the City of Garfield to retain Appraisal Systems to provide appraisal services relating to the defense of County and State tax appeals for the 2013 Tax Year; and

6. The contract may be terminated at any time by the City of Garfield with 30 days prior notice.
7. Appraisal Systems will work on such Appeals as directed by the Garfield City Manager.

A Resolution Authorizing Environmental Remediation and Financial Services LLC (ERFS) to Complete Up To Four Soil Borings Within the MacArthur Avenue Right of Way Adjacent to 199 MacArthur Avenue, Garfield, New Jersey.

WHEREAS, ERFS is undertaking an environmental investigation at 199 MacArthur Avenue, Garfield, Bergen County, N.J., and;

WHEREAS, a soil boring sample is necessary as a 1,000 gallon heating oil underground storage tank (UST) was removed from beneath the sidewalk of the site on October 4, 2012 by Lombardo Environmental Inc. Evidence of a petroleum discharge was noted during the UST removal and a limited soil excavation was completed, and;

WHEREAS, Analytical results of post excavation soil samples collected along the excavation sidewall adjacent to the on-site building (199-1) and adjacent roadway (199-3) exceeded the NJDEP soil cleanup guideline of 5,100 for extractable petroleum hydrocarbon (EPH).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, ERFS is hereby authorized to conduct soil boring and sampling of soil within the Right-of-Way of MacArthur Avenue adjacent to 199 MacArthur Avenue subject to the following conditions:

1. ERFS shall hold the City harmless from any actions concerning their operation and all appropriate permits are secured.
2. Copies of all test results shall be forwarded to the City Clerk at the time this information is transmitted to the NJDEP.
3. At the conclusion of this operation, the location shall be fully restored with either asphalt or concrete depending on location and subject to the approval of the City Engineer.
4. ERFS will contact the Garfield Police Department to arrange traffic control.
5. ERFS shall be responsible for the maintenance of this location until proper closure is completed.

CITIZENS AND TAXPAYERS

Mr. Paul Urgavitch, 52 Elizabeth Street, spoke on receiving a notice from the Building Department to repair the sidewalk in front of his property. He complained that the shade tree the City had planted is lifting his sidewalk.

Ms. Deborah Smith, 341 East 35th Street, Paterson, NJ 07504, and Ms. Sonia Swan 132 West First Street, Clifton, New Jersey, both representatives of the North Jersey Developmental Center, said that the Center is being closed by the State. They asked the Council to pass a resolution to keep this center, for the developmental disabled, open.

Mr. Anthony LoDeca, 95 Malcolm Avenue, complained about Fragales Bakery at 64 Gaston Avenue. He said that he is losing tenants due to noisy deliveries, trucks and people playing loud music.

COUNCILMEMBER COMMENTS

Councilmember Calandriello congratulated and thanked Charles Janesak on his many years of service and he spoke on his resignation from the Library Board of Trustees. He said that he was a really great Board Member and he was Chairman for many years. He said that he hopes he enjoys his time being retired. He spoke on City Tax Appeals and spoke on what he claimed was the special treatment received by Venture One. He said that if it is a Building Department issue, that is one thing, but there is an established Tax Court in Bergen County and the minute politicians start handling these things individually, it is wrong. He said that it is a bad practice which might set a precedent.

Councilmember Aloia spoke on the North Jersey Development Center issue and he said he would like to see other resolutions from other municipalities before approving one. He said that he does not want to appear anti-Community Home but when Community Homes, are put in, it is a compassionate thing, but they do not pay taxes and that is the price we pay. He suggested that Mr. LoDeca meet with the owner of Fragales Bakery to try to address his concerns.

Deputy Mayor Raymond said that the City needs to be responsible and needs to help where it can. She said that Developmental Homes with 300 residents need modern equipment. She said that Group Homes are good things but they are not for everyone. She congratulated the Garfield Police on a recent incident where an individual crashed a car, tried to carjack another car and then hid in a house where the Police arrested him.

Councilmember Mati told Mrs. Smith that she has the support of the Mayor and Council. He told Mr. Lo Deca that he will do what he can about the bakery. He spoke on the Venture One tax issue.

He said that he does not know why the Government cuts what it does but wastes money on a special election for a new U.S. Senator.
